Minutes of Regula: Meeting February 6, 2018

The Grady County Board of Commissioners met for a Regular Meeting on Tuesday, February S, 2018 with Chairman Ray Prince, Vice Chairman TD David and Commissioners NaFaye Copeland, June Knight and Keith Moye in attendance. Also present were County Clerk Carrie Croy and County Attorney Jennifer Herzog.

Mr. Prince called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. and asked Mrs. Copeland to give the invocation, followed by the pledge of allegiance.

Mr. David made a motion to adopt the Agenda with Mr. Moye making the second. The Board approved unanimously.

Mir. Prince called for Public Comments. Mis. Betty Godwin, 369 Pine Park Road, stated she was continuing her comments from the previous meeting and shared concerns regarding the draft RFQ stating quality issues with the product. Mis. Godwin said the RFQ refers to a Procurement Office and asked if such exists. She further pointed out that the Market Study appeared to be a "cut and paste" document with conflicting information and inconsistencies.

Mr. Peter Wright, Stephens Road, commended Ms. Godwin on her comments and taking the time to review the document line by line. He further stated "the public pays and the private proffers".

Mr. Charlie Norton, Former Commissioner, discussed his concerns for the direction of the lake and the debt repayment. He shared history going back to 2004 and the meeting with then Governor Perdue. Mr. Norton stated tax payers have funded this for years and the numbers do not match up. He stated this is not the Country Club. Mr. Norton stated there are large expenditures on the near horizon and the Board needs to be careful. He closed by stating the lake was built for everyone-not a select few.

Mr. Rodney Gordon, EMS Director, discussed the need to purchase new Cardiac Heart Monitors. Two bids were received and several payment options were discussed. PAr. Gordon recommends going with the company Zoll and using the five year plan. Mr. Moye made a motion to purchase the Cardiac Monitors from Zoll with the five year plan. Mrs. Copeland made the second with the Board unanimously approving the purchase. The funds will come from the contingency line item of the budget. A bid was also received from Stryker.

The Following Correspondence was reviewed:

- $^\circ$ The Calendar of Events. Mr. David asked the Board to add April $13^{'0}$ as the G4 Retreat.
- 3 Or. Martin Lither King, In. Grady County Collaborative Banquet Information. It was the

consensus of the Board to waive an cental fact for the Agri-Lencer as a sponsorship.

A Planning Commissioner Letter of Resignation from Mr. Gary Iones.

Mr. Moye made a motion to approve the following Consent items with Mrs. Knight making the second. The Board unanimously approved the following items:

- * Winutes from the January 15, 2018 Regular Meeting, January 22, 2013 Special Called Meeting, January 22, 2018 Closed Session, January 29, 2018 Public Hearing, January 30, 2018 Special Called Meeting and January 30, 2018 Closed Session.
- *Appointed Commissioner David to serve on the Library Trustee Board. This was to replace Ms. Anne Wooter who did not wish to be reappointed. This is a five year term.
- *Approved participating in the 4th of July Fireworks Show. The County's partion is \$4,000.00.
- * Approved Family Subdivision Plat for the Emogene Miller Estate.

Mrs. Sacky Bracewell, Recreation Director, presented her requests for Spring Sports Equipment Purchases. Mr. Moye made a motion to purchase equipment from 85N Sports in the amount of \$3,836.85 and from R&S Sports in the amount of \$3,503.85. Mr. David made the second with the Board unanimously approving the purchases. These are scheduled budget items.

Changes to the Manufactured Home and Trailer Regulations were discussed. Mr. David made a motion to approve the suggested changes with Mr. Moye making the second. After discussion, the motion was rescinded by both. The item was tabled for the attorney to look at the wording.

Discussion occurred concerning the adoption of Public Participation Procedures for Commissioner Meetings. After Discussion, Mr. Moye made a motion to adopt the Public Participation Procedures prepared and presented by Mr. David and Attorney Herzog. Mr. David made the second with the Board approving unanimously. These will be available prior to every meeting.

Mrs. Copeland thanked Mrs. Croy and Mr. Elkins for having the "Children at Play" signs erected on Upper Hawthorne Trail.

Mr. Prince updated the Board on the landfill project and the meetings with Decatur County and Thomas County.
