

Notice of Property Tax Increase

The Grady County Board of Commissioners has tentatively adopted a millage rate of 14.653 mills, which will require an increase in property taxes by 14.03 percent over the rollback rate. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 12.85 mills.

All concerned citizens are invited to attend any of the three public hearings on this proposed tax increase to be held in the Grady County Board of Commissioners meeting room on the first floor of the Grady County Courthouse, 250 North Broad Street, Cairo, GA on:

- Thursday, August 10, 2017 at 6:00 p.m.
- Tuesday, August 17, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 14.653 mills, an increase of 1.0 mills.

The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$100,000 is approximately \$68.51 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$250,000 is approximately \$180.30.
