Sec. 52-1. Uniform Rules of the Road adopted.

(a) Pursuant to O.C.G.A. tit. 40, ch. 6, §§ 40-6-372 through 40-6-376, §§ 40-6-2 to 40-6-395 of that chapter known as the Uniform Rules of the Road and the definitions contained in O.C.G.A. § 40-1-1 are hereby adopted as and for the traffic regulations of this county with like effect as if recited herein.

(b) Unless another penalty is expressly provided by law, every person convicted of a violation of any provision of this chapter shall be punished in accordance with section 1-12 unless otherwise provided by state law.
