- (a) Pursuant to O.C.G.A. tit. 40, ch. 6, §§ 40-6-372 through 40-6-376, §§ 40-6-2 to 40-6-395 of that chapter known as the Uniform Rules of the Road and the definitions contained in O.C.G.A. § 40-1-1 are hereby adopted as and for the traffic regulations of this county with like effect as if recited herein.
- (b) Unless another penalty is expressly provided by law, every person convicted of a violation of any provision of this chapter shall be punished in accordance with section 1-12 unless otherwise provided by state law.
