

GRADY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

MEETING MINUTES

May 16, 2023, Meeting

The Grady County Board of Commissioners met on May 16, 2023, at 6:00 pm for a regular meeting. Commissioners LaFaye Copeland, Ray Prince, June Knight, Keith Moye, Phillip Drew, County Administrator Buddy Johnson, County Clerk John White, County Finance Director Holly Murkerson, County Attorney Gabe Ridley, and Road Superintendent Stanley Elkins were present.

Mr. Drew opened the meeting with the invocation and pledge to the flag.

Motion by Mr. Prince, second by Mrs. Knight to amend the agenda to include FA032-23 and FA033-23. The motion was approved.
