PRESENTATIONS

Mr. Field Searcy, Mr. Sam Carline, and Mrs. Arlene Spooner spoke for Georgians for Truth to state why they feel paper ballots should be used for all elections held in Grady County. Several citizens spoke about their thoughts on elections, and it is a trust issue.

Denise Maddox, Election Superintendent and Probate Judge, Judge Maddox discussed the voting process that the state requires. Judge Maddox certifies voting results in Grady County.

Attorney Ridley did some research and advised as to why he feels the county nor Judge Maddox has the authority to decide what voting method they will use for elections. Mr. Ridley stated that Georgia law states that elections must be the same throughout the state. There are two court cases that are challenging Georgia's election law and how the voting is conducted.

Mr. Drew stated that the board will follow the opinion of our attorney on this matter. Mr. Moye made the motion to adjourn the workshop and the workshop was adjourned.
