Iva J Martin, 222 Longleaf Lane

Mrs. Martin talked about issues they are having in Pine Park Estates and how the covenant is not being enforced. She discussed several issues that have occurred in the past with lots in the subdivision being divided when they should not be. The issue was referred to Attorney Ridley for him to investigate the issue.

Michael Cook, 184 Carr St

Mr. Cook asked about the minimum lot size going from one acre lots to 1.5 acre lots.

The Planning Commission and the Board of Commissioners discussed Tiny Houses and other loopholes in our ordinances. After much discussion, the Board of Commissioners asked Code Enforcement Director Brian Harrison and the Planning Commission to look at the ordinances and provide input into what needs to be added, updated, and/or fixed.

Mr. Dorsey asked if there was a brick wall or something as to why we do not have zoning in Grady County. Several commissioners stated we will have to look in that direction.

The board then asked Mr. Ridley to draft a Resolution for the Tiny House Moratorium for them to vote on at their meeting on January 2, 2024.
