Vice Chair Carnline called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm and opened with prayer. Vice Chair Carnline thanked everyone for attending and asked that all cell phones be silenced.

Vice Chair Carnline requested the agenda be approved, Member Mills made a motion to approve, seconded by Member Gwaltney, and passed unanimously. Vice Chair Carnline asked members to review January 5th, 2026, meeting minutes. Member Gwaltney made a motion to approve, seconded by Member Mills, and passed unanimously.

A presentation was given by Field Searcy on an analysis of tabulator system log files (SLOG Files) from seven Georgia counties, including Grady County, focusing on the 2024 general election. Other Georgia counties included were Bibb, Cherokee, Fayette, Floyd, Gwinnett & Houston. The presenter clarified the analysis does not allege that vote totals were altered or point to any wrongdoing at the county level.

Motion to approve the consolidation and renaming of Grady County voting precincts was made by Member Mills, seconded by Member Reagan and passed unanimously. This results in reducing 13 precincts to 9 to mirror the current 9 polling places.

A special Voter Challenge Hearing date has been scheduled for March 10th @ 5:30. This meeting will be held at the Grady County Courthouse. County Attorney, Gabe Ridley will be invited to attend this hearing.

Member Mills made a motion to notify all voters identified with incorrect/non valid addresses via Certified Mail, seconded by Member Gwaltney and passed unanimously.

Candidate Qualifying is scheduled for March 2nd-6th.

Tate will attend the GAVREO Conference in Athens March 22nd-25th and Butler will attend via web conference.

Next meeting will be held **March 2nd at 5:30 PM.**
